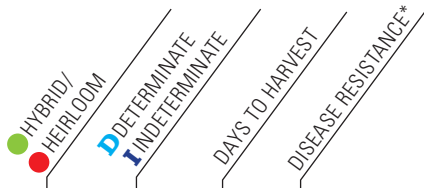

Green	D	70-80	VFN		<b>ACE</b>	LATE season. Med. large, uniform, firm red fruit up to 1 lb. or more. Heavy crop. Excellent quality.
Green	I	80	VFN		<b>BEEFMASTER</b>	Extra large, meaty, deep red fruit up to 2 1/2 lbs. or more.
Green	I	80-90			<b>BEEFSTEAK</b>	Meaty, bright red, 12 oz. fruit.
Green	I	70	VFN		<b>BETTER BOY</b>	Globe shaped fruit up to 1 lb. High yielder. Outstanding variety.
Green	I	73			<b>BIG BEEF</b>	Early maturity, superior disease tolerance, bears twice as many fruit of x-large varieties in its class.
Red	I	65			<b>BLACK CHERRY</b>	This is the first true black cherry tomato that has the classic black tomato flavor.
Red	I	75-90			<b>BLACK KRIM</b>	3-4" beefsteak slightly flattened dark red, maroon, deep green shoulders. Fantastic, intense, slightly salty taste.
Red	I	70			<b>BLACK PRINCE</b>	Round, black-brown skin, 5 oz., sweet and rich, early large crop, very productive.
Red	I	72			<b>BLACK ZEBRA</b>	3-4 oz. deep burgundy fruit has jagged green stripes on the outside; solid mahogany flesh inside. Sweet and juicy.
Green	I	75-78			<b>BRANDY BOY</b>	Excellent slicing tomato. 4-5 times the yield of Brandywine, 14 oz.
Red	D	90-100			<b>BRANDYWINE</b>	A very fine-flavored tomato. Vigorous, good yields of large, firm, rose-pink fruits. 1 1/2 lbs.
Red	I	87			<b>BULLS HEART</b>	Produces good yields of giant 2 lb. and large pink oxheart tomatoes. Very sweet and flavorful.
Red	I	80			<b>CASPIAN PINK</b>	Russian, large pink fruit, 10 - 12 oz., sweet, rich flavor.
Green	D	65-70	VFNT		<b>CELEBRITY</b>	Firm, large 5-7 oz. fruit with exceptional flavor.
Green	D	62	VFFT		<b>CHAMPION</b>	Bred especially for sandwiches. High yields, excellent performer. 10 oz. fruit.
Red	I	72-90			<b>CHEROKEE PURPLE</b>	10-12 oz. fruit. Dusky pink skinned fruit with dark shoulders. Rich full flavor compare to Brandywine.
Green	I	55			<b>EARLY GIRL</b>	Strong indeterminate vine. Very early. Fruit size 4-6 oz.

●		85	VFN	<b>FANTASTIC</b>	Beefsteak-type tomato produces and abundance of 3-5" fruit.
●	D	49		<b>FOURTH OF JULY</b>	Producing small, luscious fruits, Fourth of July is one of the earliest producing cherry tomatoes you can grow.
●		80		<b>GERMAN JOHNSON</b>	Large, slightly ribbed pink-red fruit avg 1 lb. Meaty w/few seeds, really excellent flavor. Perfect for sandwiches.
●		85		<b>GOLIATH</b>	Grown since the late 1800's. Huge fruit to 3 lbs. Dark pink, ribbed, few seeds, and very sweet w/acid component.
●	D	78		<b>GREEN ZEBRA</b>	Produces good yields of 3 oz. green tomatoes with dark green stripes. Old fashioned tomato flavor. Stays green.
●		68	VFN	<b>HEARTLAND</b>	Compact plants 6-8 oz. fruit. Excellent garden performance.
●		85		<b>HILLBILLY</b>	From W. Virginia, huge bicolored fruit is yellow-orange w/red streaking. 1 - 2 lbs., sweet and fruity flavor.
●		67		<b>ISIS CANDY</b>	Yellow-gold cherry tomatoes w/red marbling. 3/4" fruit, sweet, rich, and fruity.
●		90		<b>JAPANESE TRIFELE</b>	Black pear-shaped variety from Russia, excellent sweet and complex flavor.
●		66		<b>JELLY BEAN</b>	Fantastic sweet flavor, grape-sized fruit resists cracking.
●		64		<b>JETSETTER</b>	EARLY season. 8-10 oz. Great for short season, disease resistant, Good, rich flavor with high yields.
●		70-75		<b>JUBILEE</b>	Meaty, bright golden-orange fruit of medium size, non-acidic.
●		60		<b>JULIET</b>	Heavy yields of sweet, red, 1 oz. oblong fruit. Crack resistant.
●		80		<b>KELLOGG'S BREAKFAST</b>	Very large 1-2lb beefsteak with orange skin, few seeds and a tangy, rich flavor.
●	D	76		<b>LA ROMA</b>	Large 5-8 oz. fruit, excellent for tomato paste, cooking. Vigorous plant with excellent disease resistance.
●		72	VFN	<b>LEMON BOY</b>	Lemon yellow with large harvests 8-12 oz. Outstanding flavor, mild and sweet yet tangy. Most popular.
●		60	VFN	<b>MOMOTARO</b>	Round 8 oz. fruit has a slight pink tinge and a delicious classic tomato flavor.
●		70	VFN	<b>MORTGAGE LIFTER</b>	Produces good yields of 1 - 2 lbs. beefsteak tomatoes. Sweet, rich flavor, turns deep pink when mature.
●		56		<b>MR STRIPEY</b>	Huge crops of red fruits with clearly defined yellow-orange stripes. 1 1/2 to 2" fruit have a rich, tangy flavor.
●		80		<b>ORANGE STRAWBERRY</b>	Large orange oxheart, 8 oz. to 1 lb. Exceptionally rich and sweet flavor with just the right amount of acid.
●	D	70	VFN	<b>PATIO</b>	Great for containers, only 2 ft. tall plant, 3-4 oz. red fruit is rich and flavorful.
●		85		<b>PINEAPPLE</b>	Bicolored red and yellow fruit, very large, up to 2 lbs. Streaked w/red inside and out. Rich, fruity, and sweet.
●		75		<b>PRUDEN'S PURPLE</b>	Beefsteak, 10-16 oz., dark pink fruit, potato-leaved vines, matures early. Delicious flavor and good production.
●		70-75		<b>RED CHERRY</b>	Delicious, rich, red and juicy. 1 1/4 - 1 1/2 inch fruit.
●	D	100		<b>RED GRAPE</b>	Oblong 1 oz. fruit. Sweet, distinctive tomato flavor not commonly found in cherry tomatoes.

		78		<b>RED PEAR</b>	Miniature pear-shaped fruit are 1 3/4 to 2" long and bright red. Flavorful and sweet, great for salads.
	D	78	VFN	<b>ROMA</b>	Italian pear, 2-3 oz. fruit. Very productive and of good quality. Meaty tomato with little pulp.
		85		<b>SAN MARZANO</b>	Italian Roma-type later to mature than Roma, but larger fruit size, 3 1/2 - 4", ideal for canning. Large clusters.
	D	75	VFN	<b>SHADY LADY</b>	Large leaves shade fruit from scalding sun. Excellent, smooth, quality 6-7 oz. fruit.
		50		<b>STUPEICE</b>	High yield of 2-3" round fruit, that is juicy with a bright and rich flavor.
		65-75		<b>SUGAR LUMP</b>	From Germany, sweet cherry 3/4 - 1" fruit, excellent eating quality and flavor, produces heavy yields into fall.
		57		<b>SUNGOLD</b>	Bright orange, bite-sized fruit grows in clusters. Prolific producer, sweet as candy, great for salads or snacking.
		62-67		<b>SUNSUGAR</b>	Heavy yields of yellow-orange cherry tomato clusters. Very sweet with fruity overtones. Longtime favorite.
		70	VFN	<b>SUPER FANTASIC</b>	High yields of solid, meaty, 10 oz. fruit.
		80	VFN	<b>SUPERSTEAK</b>	The original "giant" with beefsteak taste and meaty texture. 2 lbs.
		65		<b>SWEET BABY GIRL</b>	High yield of medium salad tomatoes with a bright, tangy flavor.
		65	FNT	<b>SWEET MILLION</b>	An improved version of Sweet 100. Same wonderful flavor and yields, better disease resistance and less cracking.
		65		<b>SWEET ONE HUNDRED</b>	Huge, multiple-branched clusters of 1/2", very sweet fruit w/high vitamin C content. Mouth-watering flavor.
	D	68		<b>TOMATILLO PURPLE</b>	Purple fruit, smaller, 1" in diameter, sharper flavor than green, easy to grow. Recommend 2 or more plants.
	D	50-60		<b>TOMATILLO VERDE</b>	Husked fruit 2" - 3" diameter. Main ingredient in salsa. Recommend 2 or more plants.
		78	V	<b>TIE DYE</b>	A Burpee exclusive variety. Beautifully marbled w/ red and gold streaks. 7 oz. fruit, sweet, rich, and non-acidic.
		65		<b>WHOPPER</b>	Huge tomatoes, 4" across, deep red, very prolific. Juicy, crack resistant, sweet and flavorful.
		90		<b>YELLOW BRANDYWINE</b>	Large yellow fruit of exceptional quality, creamy texture and delicious flavor. 12 - 24 oz.
		72		<b>YELLOW JUBILEE</b>	Mild flavor, low acid, bright golden-orange 6-7 oz. with meaty, thick walls with few seeds.
		78		<b>YELLOW PEAR</b>	Miniature pear-shaped tomatoes are 1 3/4 - 2" long and clear yellow in color.
